2. The need for rules which achieve order, ensure privacy and protect property.
3. The identification of computer ethics rules.
4. The use of case studies to analyse netiquette related issues.

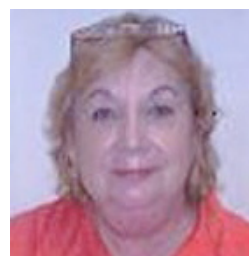
